Subject	Task	Time

These cards are for Macbeth revision and should be created using the model provided in class. Pupils should also annotate the selected pages from their Pink Language Revision guide. The notes taken from relevant Massolit lectures will be provided for pupils and pupils will be shown how to access it.	2 Hours
Maths	Pupils should complete the past paper they have been given by their class teacher.	1.5 Hours
Biology	Pupils should complete the revision booklet they have been given in class. This booklet covers all the required practicals that pupils need to know for their Mock Exam.	1 Hour
Chemistry	Pupils should complete the revision booklet they have been given in class. This booklet covers all the required practicals that pupils need to know for their Mock Exam.	1 Hour
Physics	Pupils should complete the revision booklet they have been given in class. This booklet covers all the required practicals that pupils need to know for their Mock Exam.	1 Hour
RE	Pupils should complete the different activities they have been given by their class teacher. This includes: answering a B, C and D question on Judaism: Beliefs and Teachings (45 mins), annotating sample answers (25 mins) and a revision task to complete from pages 42-44 on Death and the afterlife (25 mins).	1.5 Hours
MFL	Foundation Level – Students should complete all Module 6 Foundation reading and writing tasks from the booklet they have been given in class (1 hour) and revise general conversation questions for their speaking exam (30 minutes) Higher Level – Students should complete all Module 6 Higher reading and writing tasks from booklet (1 hour) and revise General conversation questions for speaking exam (30 minutes)	1.5 Hours
History	Western Front Summary: Pupils should complete all of the questions in full using the revision guides sent to all students via Teams. This recaps knowledge on the Western Front source paper for the 3 different question stems students will encounter in the exam.	1.5 Hours
Geography	Pupils should use the revision mats to summarise key areas of the specification content using brief notes, bullet points and diagrams. Pupils should revise by using the knowledge retrieval questions. These are quick questions to answer to test your knowledge or build your knowledge on all areas of the specification	2 Hours

Computing	Pupils should complete the practice exam questions for component 1 and component 2. Pupils have been given these exam questions in class.	1.5 Hours
BTEC Digital Media	Pupils should complete a learning aim A assessment. Pupils should use the learning aim A checklist to ensure that all content has been included in the report.	1.5 Hours
PE	Pupils are to complete the "5 a-day" exam booklet. It's a simple format, and we would like you to spend 30 mins a day. Answer the 5 questions and then check your answer against the mark scheme in the back of the booklet, and green pen the model answer.	30 mins per day
BTEC Sport	Unit 2 Practical Performance in Sport - Learning Aim A Complete writing up Rules, Regulations and Scoring Systems in both Rounders and Badminton. Write up 4 situations from Badminton and 4 situations from Rounders that would require your intervention as an official, explain clearly what happened in each instance, what action you took as the official and how did you restart the game? Explain and discuss the roles and responsibilities of each official in Badminton and each official in Rounders. This work is part of their coursework and should take 2 hours to complete correctly.	2 Hours

Engineering	Pupils should complete the booklet of exam questions they have been given in class. This booklet covers 9 mark question preparation for Unit 01 Understanding the engineering world.	40 minutes
Textiles	Pupils should complete the practice exam questions booklet. The questions are a similar style to the questions in the Section A part of the exam. Pupils have been given these exam questions in class.	1 Hour
Food	Pupils should complete the 99 multi-choice questions in the layout of section A of the exam. Students have to justify their answers. Pupils should use their booklets and revision guide for help/reference.	1.5 Hours
Health and Social Care	Pupils should complete the booklet of questions and activities relating to Aim A – factors influencing Health and development.
